## Americans with Disabilities Act Policy Senior Services and Transportation

The <u>CITY OF PLEASANTVILLE</u> operates it's programs and services without regard to any disability in accordance with The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) as amended. These programs include:

Doctor Appointments, Medical Treatment and Lab work are available to senior citizens 62 and older or anyone with a certified disability. A 24 hour notice is required, and is subject to availability and scheduling restraints. Transportation is not available on Wednesdays and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of the month due to regularly scheduled shopping trips. Any person who believes that he or she has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under the ADA may file a complaint in writing to the <u>CITY OF PLEASANTVILLE</u>.
