Preliminary Eligibility Requirements

- Ages 16 to 24;
- Must be a citizen or eligible alien;
- Low income individual (see poverty guidelines above);
- Males ages 18 through 24 must be registered with Selective Service; and have a barrier in one or more of the following categories:
 1. Deficient in basic skills literacy (computes or solves problems, reads, writes or speaks English at or below the 8th grade level on a general accepted standardized test).
 2. School dropout;
 3. Homeless, runaway, or foster child;
 4. Pregnant or parenting;
 5. Offender; or
 6. An individual (including a youth with a disability) that requires additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment.
